Upon election and for three years, the nominating school commits to providing financial support for its nominee to attend each year's NCSSES Professional Conference, which typically includes a three-night stay, and two in-person board meetings. Two Board meetings are virtual (October and June). The in-person meetings are held late January/early February, preceding the Leadership Summit; and in March/April in Washington, DC. **If the nominee is elected, he or she will be expected to attend the 2024 Professional Conference, November 6-9, in San Antonio, beginning with the Opening Reception on November 6.** The expectation is that board members attend all meetings and conferences from beginning to end to properly conduct the board business that needs to be accomplished.

If a director is unable to attend a board meeting, then he or she must notify the President in writing at least two weeks prior to that meeting, and he or she must designate a proxy to attend in his or her place. A director is allowed to send a proxy as his/her representative to no more than one board meeting per school year.
